- **Spring 2017:** Course and Curriculum committee members schedule time at C&C meeting to present proposals for approval/revision
- **Summer 2017:** Associate Dean sends email to general CNS faculty pointing to curriculum website to review and comment on proposed legislation
- **September 2017:** Last-minute revisions due to general CNS faculty comments. Subsequent review by departmental and Course and Curriculum committee. All approved legislation forwarded from Course and Curriculum to Office of General Faculty by **September 29, 2017**
