#### INNOVATION IN TEACHING THROUGH INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIPS

- 2014 2011 Planned and executed the inaugural UT in NYC course offering in 2011 with Visiting Professor Iris Apfel. This course was designed to bring apparel design and retail merchandising students together for an integrated look at the industry with an entrepreneurial focus by introducing them to industry leaders and rising stars. Students were assigned an experiential learning model to record the trip and to evaluate the experience. Building on the success of the 2011 and 2012 conference and seminar, we organized another tour in May of 2013. The addition of an alumni and friends component of the program was added to the 2012 trip and continued in 2013.
- 2014-2007 Continued to strengthen the partnership with Neiman Marcus through the corporate store development and visual presentation offices. The advanced merchandising course for senior retail merchandising students has completed its fifth year. The course features advanced store design, site location, target market development and branding practices, marketing plans and professional presentation skills. Course emphasizes interaction with senior executives of Neiman Marcus through mentoring and seminars on store planning, and the role of product placement and allocation, marketing, advertising, and visual presentation and image. Faculty and senior executives of the company jury the final project.
- 2012 and 2011 Planned and executed the inaugural Textiles and Apparel Tract in 2011 for
  the Texas Exes in NYC Seminar. Maintained the relationships established in 2011 to
  follow with another tour in 2012. Both years, guided 16 students through the NYC
  apparel industry. Coordinated visits with TXA graduates working in various facets of the
  industry who exposed students to career opportunities in New York City.

class to working within a budget, researching and planning a large scale exhibit with large-scale props. The attendance for the event is 35,000 with a net profit of \$750,000.

• Spring 2009 TXA 319 Collaborative partnership with the Women's Symphony League of Austin 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Soiree Dansante, a fundraiser attended by Austin area 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. This assignment focused on the students working in teams to meet the client's objectives of creating printed materials, centerpieces, major set backdrops for this event. The students executed storyboards to the event chairs in a professional presentation format. This opportunity exposed the class to working within a budget, researching and planning a large scale exhibit with large-scale props. The attendance for the event was over 800 with a profit of \$65,000.
